

## **Comments received from NDP Public Consultation Session held in Cross Roads on Saturday 5 April 2014**

- New homes, new families – increase in need for facilities, schools, sports, libraries etc.
- Be sustainable, build near the good transport links, don't make transport problems.
- Look after existing village and country scape – windows, roofs etc.
- Cycle route alongside Worth Valley Railway all way to Oxenhope – would this reduce cars?
- Remember what attracts tourists to the Valley, open hill scape and village etc.
- Improve the parks – perhaps some organisation of sports in Summer.
- The area also needs jobs to cut car use there needs to be some industry – not just tourists.
- Protect the views for travelling tourists on the trains.
- Don't destroy our local tourist economy by overdevelopment.
- Small care home desirable so local folk can stay local.
- If we have to build, use brown field sites, not green land. This tidies up the local area.
- Better signage, to get tourists here and move them around the District, there was a plan.
- Use 'brownfield sites' first – old vicarage, old mills etc. Small groups of affordable housing – families could be absorbed into existing community and facilities.
- Use brownfield sites for home building including starter homes. We need to maintain countryside to ensure tourism – sustainability.
- Include self build in new developments – they are affordable.
- Hotel needed in Haworth to cater for coach trips.
- Building off Halifax Road below Mormon Church or below Lees Bank or Holme Fields, cant see any other options.
- Haworth Rectory – blocked development, starter homes.

### Stanbury Issues

- Infill between School and boundary.
- Social housing needs.
- Recreational facilities need.
- Houses – 20 to 30 in Stanbury.
- Wuthering Heights – Community Pub, Shop and Café.
